

HANDOUT FOR WESTFORD TEACHERS TO OBTAIN ADDITIONAL FLETCHER LIBRARY SERVICES

ELIGIBLE TEACHERS

School teachers employed by the Westford Public School System, the Nashoba Valley Technical High School, Westford pre-schools and Home Schools are provided additional library services in support of educational curriculum and assignments

Teachers are entitled to a Teacher Library Card to be kept on file at the library and the accompanying key tag card.

TEACHER CARDS

This card entitles the holder to:

- an extended loan period of three additional weeks, on books or deposit collections for Westford items

TO APPLY FOR THIS CARD

- Teachers must fill out a special application form available at the J. V. Fletcher Library Main Desk.
- This form must be signed *by both the teacher and the principal of the school or the Home School proprietor* and returned to the library.
- The large card is kept on file at the Main Desk and must be requested each time it is used; teachers may keep the key tag card. Only the person named on the card may use the card.
